Oysters have been around for 15 million years.

Oysters can live as long as 20 years.

A single adult oyster can filter up to 50 gallons of
water per day!

More than 300 species of plants and animals live
in and among an oyster reef.

The Chesapeake Bay Foundation's (CBF's) Shell
Recycling Program reuses empty oyster shells in
efforts to restore the Chesapeake Bay's native
oyster. Used oyster shells collected across Virginia
are vital to boosting Virginia's oyster population.

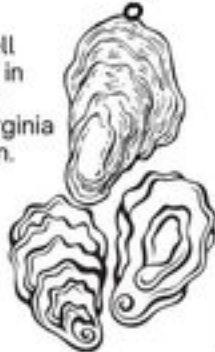
